## Case study: U-M Library website redesign

- The project manager championed accessibility.
  - Formed a dedicated accessibility team.
  - Promoted cross functional workflows that embedded accessibility.
  - Asked good questions and brought in the right people at the right times.
  - Planned for and allocated time and resources to accessibility.
  - Gathered leadership support.
- Everyone involved agreed to commit to our accessibility goal and adapt their work accordingly. It was a learning process.

\*Putting the design in the browser to work through feasibility questions and in turn also doing design in the browser (i.e. things can change!)


